

## Festival Season is Upon Us!

Howdy, Folks!

Here it is, June, already! Festival season is here!! Hope you all have your instruments tuned, voices warmed up; tunes ready to share and are ready to pick up new ones. Included in this newsletter is a Festival and Summer Event Listing, but here are some highlights:

Heritage Festival is on June 23, 24 & 25. The festival will be primarily on the south side of the tracks along Main St. this year. The Folk Festival is back in Fishel Park on Saturday from 10:00 AM to 5:30 PM (see the listing on the right for performers and times). Other concerts to watch for include: Tom Landa and the Paper Boys, a great Celtic bluegrass stomp band from Vancouver, BC, Canada; the always popular Tom

Chapin; a bluegrass band called Nob Hill; and many others!

Unfortunately, the Warrenville Folk Festival will not be going this year. But the Folk Lore Center and Acorn Coffee Bar will continue with their full summer of concerts, classes, workshops and special events. For information on their schedule, call 630/393-1247. July 8 and 9 brings the Gebhard Woods Dulcimer Festival at Gebhard Woods State Park in Morris, IL. There is a great line-up of performers as well as many opportunities for workshops, jamming, and perusing the booths of many vendors from across the Midwest with instruments, books, tapes, etc. For details on who's playing, etc., see the Festival Listing in the center of the Quarter Notes.

Other great opportunities featuring many great Midwest performers are the **Woodstock Folk Festival**, on *July 16* (Sunday); the **Lake County Folk Festival** on *August 6* (Sunday). In September, there's the **Fox Valley Folk Festival** on *Sept. 3 & 4* (Sunday and Monday), as well as the **Chinquapin Folk Music & Storytelling Festival** on *Sept. 7*,

8 & 9 (Thursday evening through Saturday).

For those of you who like Storytelling, many of these festivals include storytelling events, including one stage devoted to storytelling at the Fox Valley Folk Festival. Also right in our own back yard is the Illinois Storytelling Festival on July 29 & 30 (Saturday and Sunday) in Spring Grove, IL, devoted entirely to storytelling. Come hear great storytellers from all over the country including concerts, workshops, and a special ghost stories session. This year's theme is "Stories of the Land & Sea", featuring special guest Richard Wheeler, who kayaked from Newfoundland to Cape Cod following the migratory path of the Great Auk, an extinct species. Check the center page Festival Listing for details on all these and other summer events!

I try to let you all know as much as I can about the festivals that are going on in the area, but there are always new opportunities popping up that I don't always hear about. Also, there are many great festivals all around the country, many of which work out very nicely when included in vacation plans! I have limited our listing to the ones you can easily go to for the day. However, to get a good listing of festivals around the country, you might consider receiving the Aural Tradition's monthly newsletter. Aural Tradition not only presents a great concert series, and they put out a very nice monthly listing of events in the Chicago area, which has a great festival listing that includes the festivals around the country that you don't want to miss!
