***ALBUM RELEASE PARTY ON SAT. JUNE 15 ***

Join us on Saturday evening, JUNE 15 at 8 pm for a very special concert to celebrate the release of LEE MURDOCK'S fifth album, <u>COLD WINDS</u>. The concert will be held in Fellowship Hall of the 1st Congregational Church of Downers Grove, 1047 Curtiss in Downers Grove (the "big room" of the Two Way Street), and is jointly sponsored by the Plank Road Folk Music Society, Fox Valley Folklore Society and the Two Way Street. Special guests Mark Dvorak and Marianne Mohrhusen will also perform.

COLD WINDS will feature fifteen songs of the Great Lakes, written by Lee Murdock and by other contemporary songwriters, including two songs by Larry Penn, Kevin O'Donnell (Arranmore), David Drake, James Keelaghan, Craig

Johnson, and of course, the title cut <u>Cold Winds</u> written by Tom Kastle of Privateer.

Recording on the album began last December, and Lee was joined in the studio by many fine musicians, including Don Stiernberg (mandolin), Mirium Sturm (violin), Dave Humphreys (bass), Howard Levy (harmonica), Paul Goelz (hammered dulcimer), Drew Carson (Mandolin), and Mark Dvorak (banjo). Richly textured vocal harmonies feature the voices of Gaping Maw, Kim & Reggie Harris, Liz Carson, Phil Cooper and Margaret Nelson, Fred Campeau, Michelle Thomas and Marianne Mohrhusen.
