CARRIE NEWCOMER at HOLLYWOOD HOUSE JAN. 18

The Plank Road Folk Music Society will present an evening of original music featuring recording artist and songwriter Carrie Newcomer along with special guest Bob Janis at Brookfield's historic and intimate Hollywood House, 8540 Washington Street, Brookfield, on Saturday,

January 18 at 8 pm.

Newcomer was first introduced to midwest audiences several years ago as the leader and driving force behind the popular trio Stone Soup. Since that time, she has struck out on her own to pursue a solo performing and recording career that has taken her across the country. She has appeared at some of the nation's most prestigious clubs and festivals including the KerrvilleMusic Festival, The bluebird in Nashville, Passim, Charlotte's Web and an appearance on NPR's All Things Considered.

Her current release, Visions and Dreams, has received critical acclaim and widespread airplay. Mike Flynn's Folk Sampler says of Newcomer's

latest project, "Great stuff--Carrie's best recording to date!"

Special guest Bob Janis will open the evening with a selection of folk and pop songsas well as his own compositions; one of which country singer **Don** Williams has indicated interest in recording. "I had a very productive summer writing," recalls Janis. "I put down six or seven songs in what seemed to be a very short period of time. I became more excited about writing and performing again."

"PLANK ROAD OPRY" PREMIERES at SOKOL HALL ON MARCH 7

A gala evening of old time country music, folk music, comedy and more will be celebrated as the "Plank Road Opry" comes to Sokol Hall, 3907 Prairie, Brookfield on Saturday, March 7th at 8 pm.

The show will feature the stunning arrangements and fun of Plank Road's favorite vocal ensemble, The Hapless Creatures of Quiet Desperation, and the music, songwriting of the entertaining Bryan Dagenhart.

Also scheduled to perform are the old-time country music duet of **Dona Lee & Dave Rittenhouse** as well as an appearance by our own

Charles Lewis.

Joining ranks 1989, The Hapless Creatures was originally made up of a group of friends who enjoyed playing music together informally. Over the years they have honed both their ensemble sound and stage presentation, added instruments and expanded their repertoire to become one of the western suburbs' hottest coffeehouse attractions. They've most recently headlined at the Two Way Street Coffeehouse, and at Downers Groves' Heritage Festival.

Folk circuit veteran **Bryan Dagenhart** has been performing consistently for more than twenty years around Chicagoland. Known for his humorous and poignant original songs, Dagenhart is also regarded as being an adept interpreter of traditional ballads as well as other writers' work, having several hundred songs in his repertoire. Accompanying himself simply on guitar, Daggenhart is perhaps best known for having the ability to improvise an hilarious or touching

song right on the spot.

Dona Lee Mescher & Dave Rittenhouse began performing together only a year ago, being drawn to collaborate by their love of old-time country music. Dona Lee has sung and strummed her guitar solo and with various band and outfits for more than thirty years. Her repertoire is vast, and boasts some of the best work of country and western music's greatest stars. Dave Rittenhouse is known throughout Plank Road and Chicagoland as an excellent guitarist, having studied and performed on the instrument for thirty years. His favorite guitarists are Chet Atkins and Muriel Anderson. Together, Dona Lee and Dave have appeared at the Two Way Street, the Fox Valley Folk Festival, and at the Sundowners.

Rounding out the musical portion of the show will be Plank Road's own Charles Lewis. Charles' collection of train songs has been enjoyed by folk music lovers for the last 15 years at coffeehouses, clubs and model railroading clubs. His subtle humor and sure hand with the twelve string guitar have made him a favorite entertainer at the Downers Grove Heritage Festival, the Plank Road Folk Music Society and the Warrenville Folk Music Society.
