

# AN EVENING with SI KAHN MAR. 13 at FELLOWSHIP HALL

Affirmation and gentle wit are the hallmarks of the work of Si Kahn, a leading member of the current generation of activist folksingers and a nationally recognized author, lecturer and songwriter. The Plank Road Folk Music Society proudly presents "An Evening with Si Kahn" Saturday, March 13, at Fellowship Hall (in the 1st Congregational Church of Downers Grove), 1047 Curtiss, Downers Grove at 8:30 pm.

It's now almost twenty five years since Kahn first began working as an organizer and musician in the South. His work in the Southern civil rights movement was the first step on a road that has led him through the coal camps and cotton mill towns of the South, the Brookside strike in Harlan county, Kentucky; the brown lung movement and the J.P. Stevens campaign in the Carolinas; and the critical work of organizing and coalition-building among black and white, women and men, and rural and urban areas in the



and worked with during the last twenty five years- their words and songs, stories and jokes- are the stuff out of which Kahn's songs of have been woven.

Kahn continues to work as Executive Director of Grassroots Leadership, a team of organizers which provides people, communities and organizations in the South with the organizing and strategy assistance they need to confront challenges in in the areas of health care, housing, the environment, discrimination, civil rights, justice and peace.

He has released 8 albums of original songs and a double album of traditional civil rights, women's, and labor songs recorded jointly with Jane Sapp and Pete Seeger. He has authored two widely used books on training organizers published by McGraw-Hill and NASW Press. Two musicals which Kahn has scored are slated for production in 1992. "Some Sweet Day" was showcased by the National Association of Music Theater Producers at New York City's John Houseman Theater, and "Mother Jones" (starring former Weaver Ronnie Gilbert), will premier at the Milwaukee Repertory Theater. The Si Kahn Songbook was published by Hal Leonard in

"My hope is that these songs will help us find the strength in ourselves that we need

to keep on keeping on.
Unfortunately, music is not enough to change the world. It takes people working together to reach the goals that we've set for ourselves," says Kahn. "Over the past ten years, we've helped put together all of these different types of organizations from the ground up, more than a dozen new organizations in all.

"We don't just organize and run either; as they grow, we're

### HOLLYWOOD HOUSE CONCERTS MARCH 21 & APRIL 18

The Plank Road "Hollywood House" series will continue with two spring concerts to be held at Brookfield's historic Hollywood House, 8540 Washington.

March 21st, 8 pm brings the New England (they just moved!) bluegrass & country duet of **Doug & Willa Porter** along with special guest **George Mattson** to the Plank Road.

Recognized for their unique approach to acoustic music, and noted for their distinctive style, the Porters perform a wide range of bluegrass, folk and original songs and tunes as well as country standards. Doug has earned a reputation as a topnotch flat picker, while Willa's songwriting and fiddle playing are the dominant forces that flow throughout their music. They'll be performing selections from their Tuquoise Records release, "Windows."

Opening the show will be song collector and vocalist George Mattson. George has frequently appeared at the Old Town School of Folk Music's "Mr. Coffeehouse," and has literally several thousand songs in his active repertoire.
