

George Mattson in Concert on December 12!

To celebrate the release of his new CD, "All Things Considered . . . I'm Fine", George Mattson will be performing in concert Saturday, December 12th at the Two Way Street Coffee House in the large room. The concert starts at 8:00 PM. Admission is \$6.00 General, \$5.00 for PRFMS members, \$4.00 for students and seniors. Joining him will be the members of Suddenly Country and possibly other surprise guests. He'll be performing songs from the album including his long-awaited versions of "Buzzards in Love", "Smoke, Smoke, Smoke (That Cigarette)" and other songs in a wide range of styles: folk, country, old-timey and contemporary. There's even a banjo/fiddle/bass trio arrangement of Buddy Holly's "Peggy Sue" suitable to play at a hoedown. For more information on the concert call 630/968-0974.

George has been actively performing acoustic music, especially folk and old country for many years, and has played on other recordings in the past, including Plank Road's "Songs We've Shared: Down the Old Plank Road, Vol. II". He has taught guitar at the Old Town School of Folk Music and at The Folklore Center in Warrenville, and helps host the Plank Road Folk Society monthly song circle. George is known as a fine singer with a rich baritone voice and has a large varied repertoire of songs from many styles of music. He currently performs with the group, Suddenly Country which plays honky-tonk and classic country songs from the 30's, 40's, 50's and 60's, such as Hank Williams, Bob Wills, Ray Price and many more. In addition, he has performed solo playing traditional folk music, and also sings some of the finest material from contemporary songwriters. He especially likes to do humorous songs with odd twists to their stories, such as "Buzzards in Love" and "Don't Put It in Your Mouth" (which should bring back a flood of memories from your childhood). He's also known to occasionally do some jazz standards and popular songs from the 30's through the 60's.
